Required documents announcement from HU to students	March 29 <b>HU</b> sends Application guideline with the materials to the <b>nominated students</b> (CC: <b>coordinator</b> ) by email
Application Deadlines	April 12 <b>Students</b> submit ALL the Application materials to <b>HU</b>
Certificate of Eligibility (CoE) to obtain Student Visa	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● After the notification of admission, HU will assist the students to obtain ‘Certificate of Eligibility’ (CoE).</li> <li>● Please be reminded that the CoE application will become invalid if students apply for CoE individually.</li> </ul>
Orientation for Incoming Students (with other HUSA students)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● TBA (early to mid-September)</li> <li>● Orientation will cover all the important notes for exchange students, such as class registration, administrative procedures, staff introduction, cultural awareness, dormitory, student ID card, cross-cultural seminar, international events, etc.</li> </ul>
